What type of information we hold

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Name
- Contact details
- · Proof of Identity
- Date of Birth
- Financial Information, including bank statements or tax information

- Power of attorney information

How we get the information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- Tenant referencing checks, including immigration checks.
- Landlord ID checks
- · Notify you about changes to our service
- Ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner
- To administer our business and support those who work with us
- To comply with legal or regulatory requirements

What we do with the information we have

We use the information that you have given us in order to:

How we store your information

Your information is securely stored on our operating CRM software, Focus Micro system, Expert agent and Payprop.

We will only keep information about you for the following timelines:

- Tenants: The duration of the tenancy plus 12 months after the end of the tenancy.
- Landlords: The duration of the tenancy or until our services are cancelled. Plus up to a maximum of 6 years for high level information

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access – You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification – You have the right to ask us to rectify information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure – You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing – You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing – You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability – You have the right to ask that we transfer the information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
